- Providing communication in respect of regulatory matters that may affect our clients.
- Providing clients with ongoing communication on matters reflected on the website.
- Providing clients with marketing and sales related information for Chrom Consulting only.

We may also disclose your information where we have a duty or a right to disclose in terms of law or industry codes.

Safeguarding your Information:

According to South Africa's data protection law is the Protection of Personal Information Act (POPIA), we are legally obliged to provide adequate protection for the personal information we hold and to prevent any unauthorized access and/or use of personal information.
